Hornery's 4U2 Concert on September 12 will mark the first stop on The Screaming Jets "Rock n Roll Rampage" tour, meaning fans are in for one heck of a show. Dave mentioned that the first few weeks of a tour are pretty extraordinary, promising plenty of energy for the songs that everyone knows and loves.

The Jets are also promoting their new album *Kiss Me Between the Hangars*, and are keen to show off their new material.

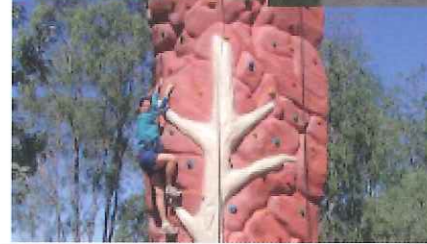
